Where are the schools located?

What are your school hours?

School hours are 8:00 a.m. -3:00 p.m. Students can arrive as early as 7:40 a.m.

Is there a cost to attend?

We are a tuition-free, public charter school. There is a \$45 school supply fee.

What is the school uniform?

Students wear closed-toed shoes, black, navy, khaki pants or jeans, and a polo shirt in a solid color depending on their grade group:

- **K-2:** Pink or Red
- **3-4 :** Green
- **5-6:** Green
- **7-8:** Black, grey or white

What curriculum is used?

Students learn in multi-age classes with a unique, nationally recognized, developmental education model that includes social-emotional learning frameworks. Specific curricula we use include:

- Common Lit
- Math Envision
- Generation Genius
- Facing History and Ourselves
- Bookworms (Near West)

What services and supports are available for students?

Counselors, Wellness Coordinators, Intervention Specialists and outside services based upon need.

Are there after-school activities?

Yes, our staff host a variety of after-school activities. The East campus hosts onsite after-care through the Boys & Girls Club of Northeast Ohio. Families sign up through the Boys & Girls Club to participate.

What do I need to enroll?
