Social-Emotional Skills

- Separates from caregiver without anxiety
- Cooperatively works with others.
- Cares about the feelings of others.
- Follows routines and directions.
- Communicates needs effectively



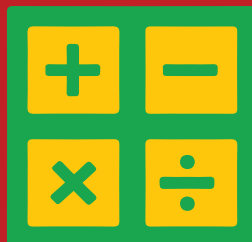
Independent Skills

- Uses restroom
- Buttons and zips own clothing.
- Ties and/or Velcro shoes.
- Cuts safely with scissors.
- Holds and uses a pencil, marker, and crayon



Math Skills

- Counts to 0 to 20 without skipping numbers
- Identifies and writes numbers 0-10
- Sort objects by size, color, and shape
- Recognizes and names basic shapes



Literacy Skills

- Recognizes letters and letter sounds
- Knows and writes first name.
- Listens to stories and answers questions
- Holds a book and turns pages one at a time
- Creates rhyming words



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
